Southwest Regional Orchid Growers Association 105th Directors and Membership Meeting Minutes

The SWROGA Directors and Membership meeting was held at the Theatre, Shreveport, LA on Friday November 1, 2013. President Don Maples called the meeting to order at 7:45PM. Carolyn McCabe reported a quorum present with 14 clubs represented.

A moment of silence was held in remembrance of those who have passed away since the last meeting. The minutes of the previous meeting were posted on the website and there was one correction. Carolyn McCabe

noted that the future dues due date was to be March 31.

Committee Reports

Affiliated Societies Committee: Lena Parker – We are still looking for committee members. One of the primary jobs of this committee is to find societies to host SWROGA shows, since no one signed on for this Fall 2013 we decided to show how it might be done with less money, time and energy investment. This meeting was put together with no goodie bags, formal banquet, or speakers. Lena turned the mike over to Jean Brewton of Tyler to float a suggestion that Trophies could be either physical or monetary. Jean requested commentary. Discussion followed both pro and con. Lena received back the mike and reported hosting of Spring of 2014 was requested by Arkansas Orchid Society and the Spring 2015 by Tyler Orchid Society. Lena moved to approve these two events. Passed. She further reiterated that no one has as yet volunteered for the Fall of 2014.

<u>AOS Rep</u>: Billie Beck Kramer – No report – absent. Don Maples requested a volunteer to replace Billie. John Stubbings volunteered.

Bylaws & Judiciary Committee: Julius Khlem - No report.

<u>Conservation Committee</u>: Charlie Hess – Discussion held in conjunction with Research Committee which will be addressed in the Research Committee report.

<u>Programs and Education Committee</u>: Lowell McCabe- No new program revisions have been completed as yet. However, current ones will be obtained from Manuel Aybar upon request.

Continuing Operating Committee: Lena Parker - No new business.

<u>Publications</u>: Don Maples – Sheila Skov not present. No report.

Research Committee- Dick Jameson – No activity. Research and Conservation met together discussing ways to include funding to conservation activities. This will be further addressed as new business. Show & Show Tags Committee: Lowell McCabe stated that show tags were breaking even as expected. Karlene Sanborn – Introduced the question of allowing SWROGA shows to be "Tabletop Exhibit" shows requiring the definition of such to be shows wherein all exhibits are on tables as opposed to a "Tabletop Show" where plants are lined up on tables according to the show schedule. Lively discussion ensued. Such shows might encourage societies with limited venue choices or personnel to host a SWROGA show. Endowed trophies for Floor Exhibits appear to be the sticking point. Families of the endowed trophies will be approached for their commentary.

<u>Treasurers Report – Carolyn McCabe passed out report to all present. Lowell McCabe moved to accept as presented.</u> Seconded by Julius Khlem.

Audit Report – Julius Khlem stated we are in good standing; Kudos to Carolyn McCabe for her outstanding job.

Old Business

The need for committee members was reiterated.

Reminder that the new fee of \$15 per society goes into effect this coming January and will be due March 31, 2014. SWROGA reps are asked to review with their society the benefits of membership in SWROGA ie. money for trophies, loan to kickstart show, auction proceeds to go to host society.

New Business

Since no Fall 2013 was certain last spring, no nominating committee was established. Therefore, Spring 2014 meeting will accept nominations from the floor for the next years officers to be voted on at the meeting. Next meeting wil be a Benton, Arkansas and hosted by the Arkansas Orchid Society, April 4th, 5th, and 6th, 2014. Thanks to Manuel Aybar for updating the website. Sandy Stubbings requested contact information for any young orchid growers to continue her interviews with the kids to help find out how to address their needs and interests. Dick Jamison proposed a change to the Procedure Manual to allow conservation efforts to be funded. Specifically: Section K – Research: first paragraph: The purpose is to advance the scientific study of orchids in any respect, including classification, evolution, propagation, culture, *conservation*, care and development. Lena Parker seconded. Motion approved.

Charlie Hess moved that SWROGA donate \$1000 from the general fund to OCA by December 2013 toward the purchase of acreage in Brazil. Donations will be met with matching donations from World Land Trust provided they are made prior to the end of 2013. Lowell McCabe seconded. Motion Passed. No further new business. The Meeting was adjourned at 9:10PM.
